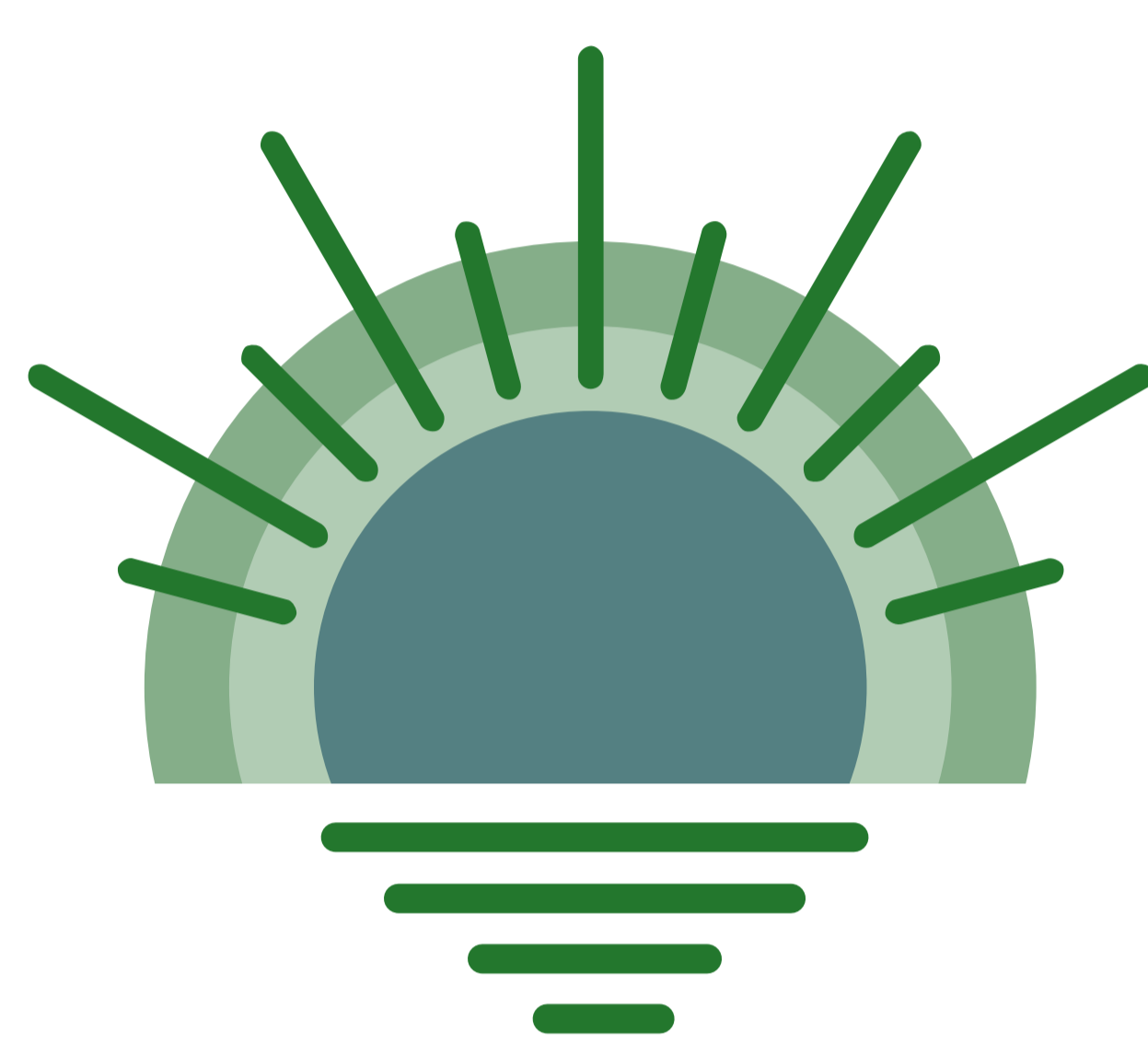


Reimagining Health and Social Care for Older Adults
