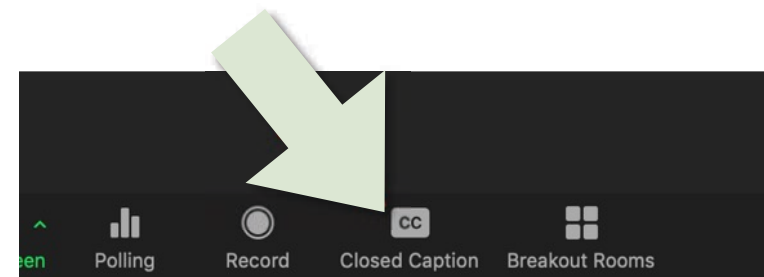
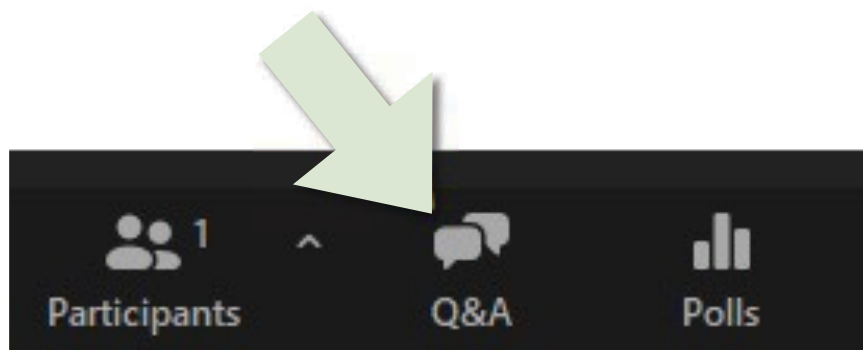

Building older adults' understanding of their political power, directly challenging misinformation, apathy, and division through targeted communications.



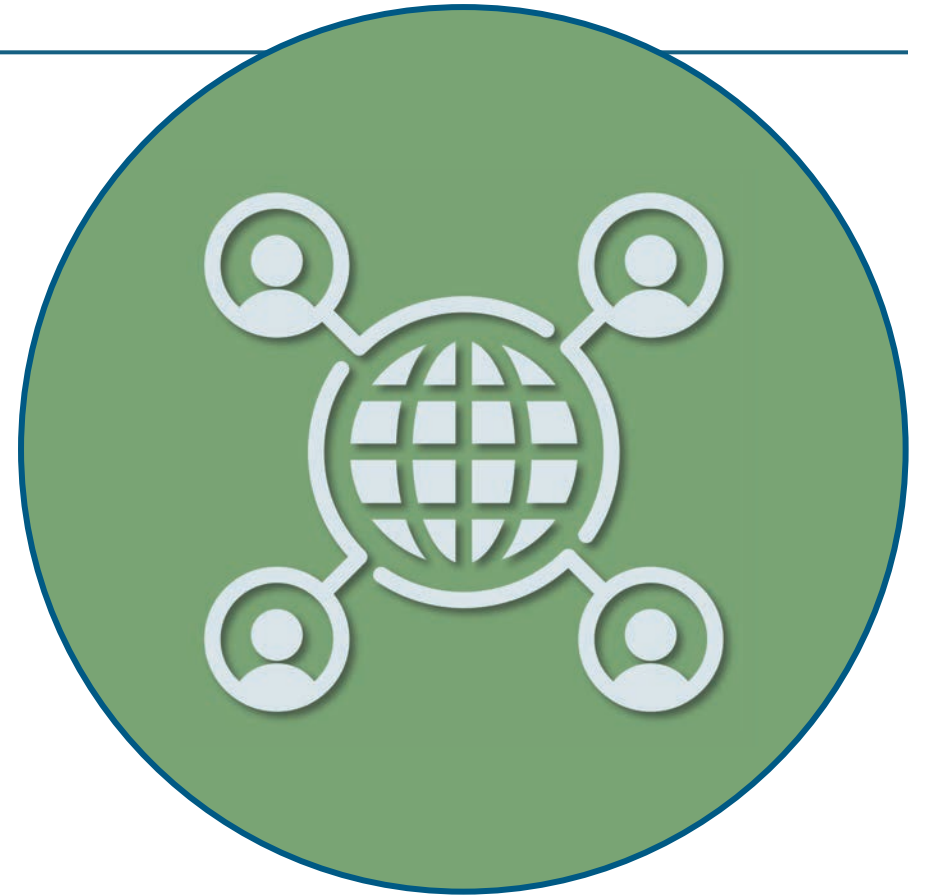
Grassroots Organizing

Flexible Funding for Small Community-Based Organizations

Providing organizations with flexible funds to invest in what they need most to achieve their goals.



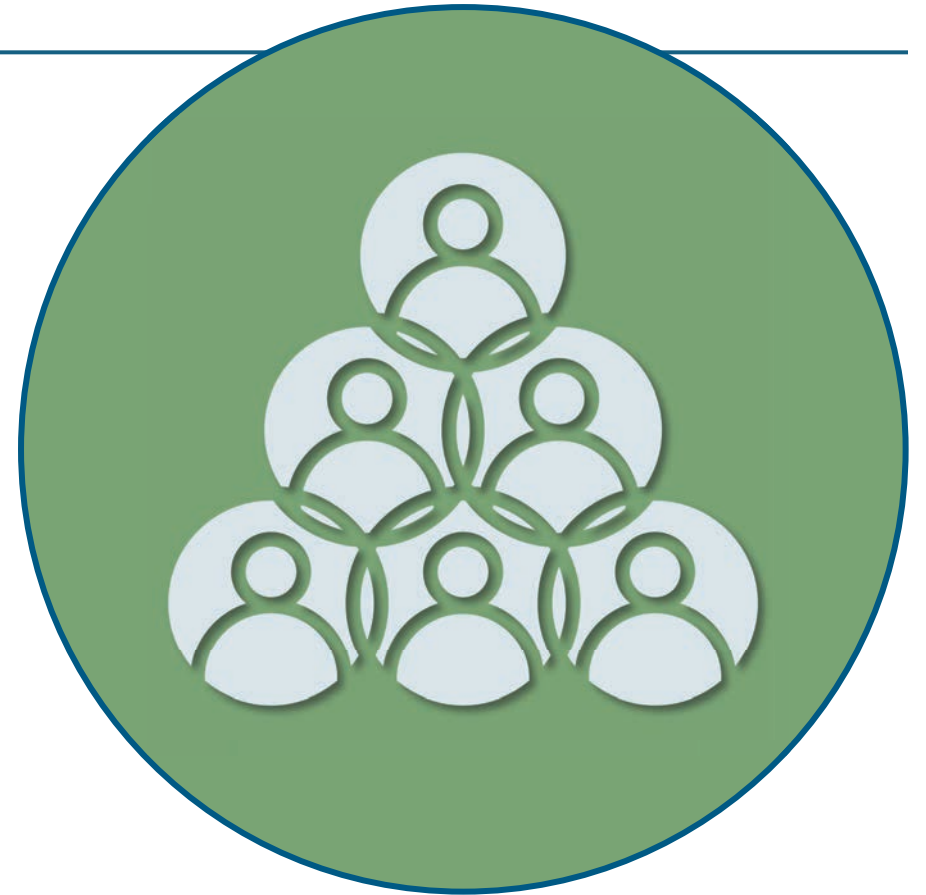
Organizational Infrastructure Support
