CalAIM Statewide Dementia Care Learning Collaborative

Key Learnings

- CalAIM already supports opportunities for improving and expanding dementia care

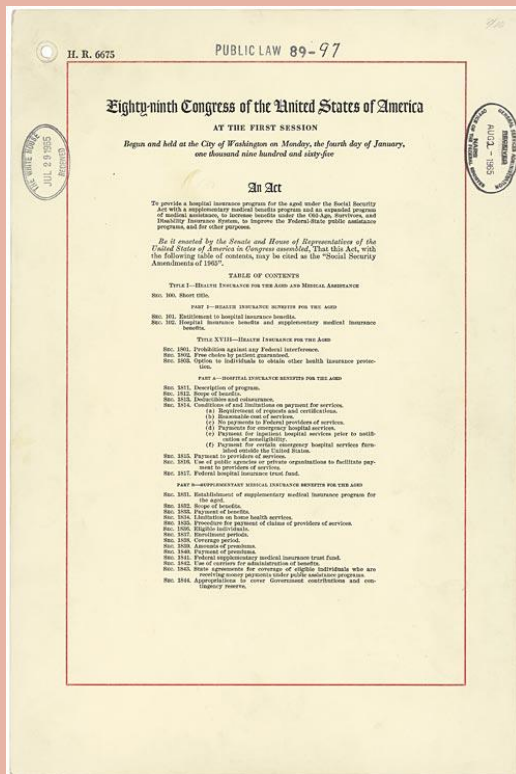

A Little History



- The Great Society 1965
 - Medicare enacted
 - Medicaid
 - A State/Federal partnership
 - Only for Women and children on welfare
- Concept of the “deserving”
- States opted in overtime
 - CA in 1967
 - Arizona in 1982

Who

- Medi-Cal Managed Care Enrollment
- Total enrollment @ 14.8 million
 - Almost all in managed care
 - All 58 counties currently operating under managed care system

Who



- 39% of all births
- 2 in 7 children
- 20% of people with disabilities
- 20% of seniors
- Regardless of documentation status

Who

- Federal poverty level
 - Varies by age and beneficiary group
- Subsidies into Covered California
- California goal – universal coverage
 - 5.5%
 - Lower side of the scale

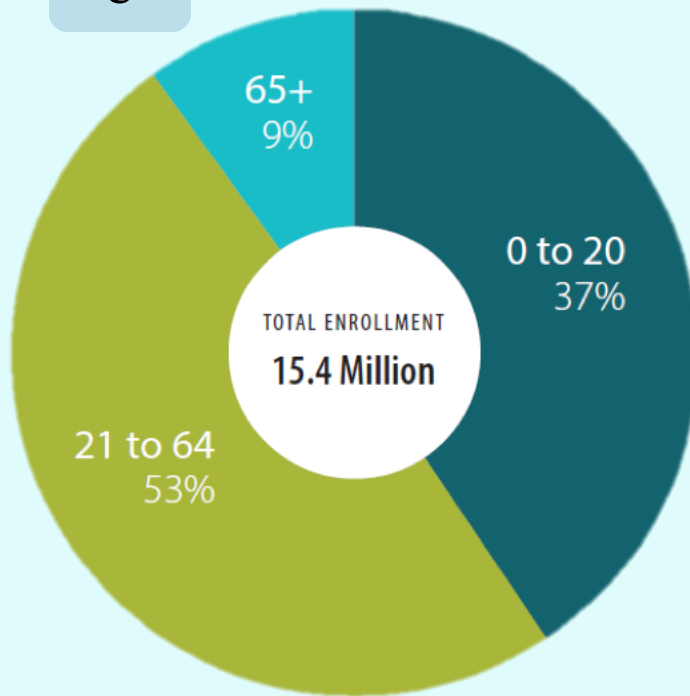

2023 Undocumented adults into Managed Care

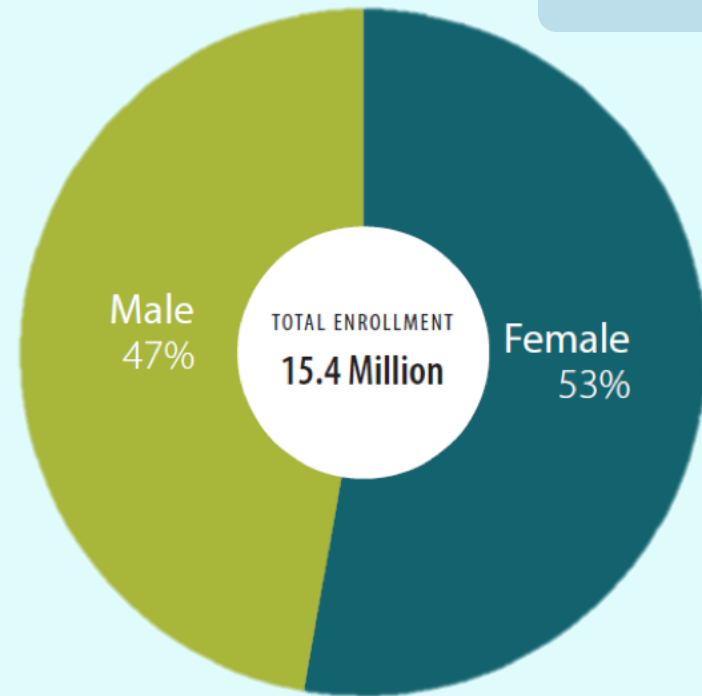
2024 Carceral individuals into Managed Care

- ✓ Mental health and substance use disorder services, including behavioral health treatment

 - ✓ Mild to Moderate fiasco
- ✓ Substance Use disorders
- ✓ Dental Services (except HPSM)
- ✓ Pharmacy
- ✓ Foster Children – except the Kaiser option
- ✓ California Children's Services
 - ✓ Whole Child Model in COHS, Kaiser
- ✓ IHSS
- ✓ Waiver community based long term services and supports
